Minutes of the meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee

The meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee for the academic year 2023-2024 was 13th September 2023 and chaired by Dr. L. Chinnappa. The Chairman welcomed all committee members and expressed gratitude for their continued support and valuable contributions during the previous semester.

The meeting began with a review of the minutes from the previous session, which were unanimously approved. It was noted that there had been a significant reduction in ragging incidents compared to the last semester, reflecting the effectiveness of the committee's efforts.

Committee members provided updates on ongoing initiatives, including the successful implementation of orientation programs aimed at educating students about the severe consequences of ragging. Discussions also centered on plans for the upcoming semester, with a focus on:

- 1. Enhanced Awareness Campaigns: Strengthening efforts to educate students about anti-ragging policies and fostering a culture of respect and inclusivity.
- 2. Collaboration with Student Organizations: Partnering with student groups to promote peer-led initiatives and create a supportive environment.
- 3. Anonymous Helpline: Introducing a confidential reporting mechanism to encourage students to report incidents without fear of retaliation.

The committee highlighted the critical role of faculty in monitoring student behavior and proposed organizing training sessions to equip them with the necessary skills to identify and address potential ragging incidents effectively. Additionally, the importance of improving student feedback mechanisms, such as conducting regular surveys, was emphasized to ensure continuous improvement in anti-ragging measures.

The meeting concluded with a strong commitment to maintaining a safe and welcoming environment for all students. The Member Secretary thanked the committee for their unwavering support in monitoring student activities and maintaining a peaceful atmosphere on campus.

In a unanimous decision, the committee resolved to work collectively as a team to ensure that junior students feel comfortable, secure, and well-settled within the PRIST Deemed-to-be University campus.

Key Recommendations for Future Actions:

- Strengthen collaboration with local authorities to ensure swift action against ragging incidents.
- Organize periodic workshops and seminars to reinforce anti-ragging awareness among students and staff.
- Develop a comprehensive database to track and analyze ragging-related complaints and resolutions.
- Encourage senior students to act as mentors for juniors, fostering a sense of responsibility and camaraderie.

The meeting was adjourned with a renewed determination to uphold the university's commitment to eradicating ragging and promoting a safe, inclusive, and respectful academic environment.

a. Infrastructure Issues:
