



Introduction

The posters provide awareness among students, regarding the types of cancer, early symptoms, diagnostic methods and preventive methods, and motivate them to avoid habits that increase therisk of cancer. The importance of cancer awareness has been emphasized as a means of ensuringbehavior that facilitates early detection, whereas the absence of cancer awareness has been seenas a detriment to this end. Delay in health-seeking is also attributed to factors such as illiteracy, financial constraints, as well as myths and superstitions along with lack of awareness and this gohand-in-hand, most of the time. Screening is an important preventive measure in cancer control. Even though the national programme in India has a screening component, it is yet to take root inmost part of the country. At present, most of the screening tests are available at higher centersonly.

Kuruvadipatti primary school is an elementary school, with grade 1 to 5. There is also a pre-primary unit in the school. The total student population is about 300. There are currently 8 teachers. The school is located about 5 kilometers from Vallam town, Thanjavur.

Assessment of the infrastructural needs

Considering that there were only 3 usable classrooms for the primary (elementary) classes of grade 1 to 5, there was a lack of 2 classrooms. The block of 3 dilapidated classrooms also needed some workmanship in order to make it learning – friendly. As it was, there were holes on the Asbestos and iron roof that obviously allowed water to leak through during the rainy season. The walls had apparent cracks and were not plastered. The windows had no cover. The floor was either dusty or with huge potholes. There were also few desks for the pupils. There was, therefore, a need to create 2 new classrooms and renovate the block of 3 dilapidated classrooms. Our PRIST NSS Cell made all kinds of work.

Tobacco causes 8 million deaths every year. Quitting can be challenging, especially with the added social and economic stress that have come as a result of the pandemic, but there are a lot of reasons to quit. Worldwide around 780 million people say they want to quit, but only 30% of them have access to the tools that can help them do so. The benefits of quitting tobacco are almost immediate. After just 20 minutes of quitting smoking, your heart rate drops. Within 12 hours, the carbon monoxide level in your blood drops to normal. Within2-12 weeks, your circulation improves and lung function increases. Within 1-9 months, coughing and shortness of breath decrease. Within 5-15 years, your stroke risk is reduced to that of a non-smoker. Within 10 years, your lung cancer death rate is about half that of a smoker. Within 15 years, your risk of heart disease is that of a non-smoker. Students of every class had taken No Tobacco pledge with students in their online classes.





WOMEN AND CHILD WELFARE AND CYBER CRIME AWARENESS PROGRAMME on 14.10.2022



BREAST CANCER AND CERVICAL CANCER AWARNESS PROGRAMME

Introduction

The posters provide awareness among students, regarding the types of cancer, early symptoms, diagnostic methods and preventive methods, and motivate them to avoid habits that increase the risk of cancer. The importance of cancer awareness has been emphasized as a means of ensuring behavior that facilitates early detection, whereas the absence of cancer awareness has been seen as a detriment to this end. Delay in health-seeking is also attributed to factors such as illiteracy, financial constraints, as well as myths and superstitions along with lack of awareness and this go hand-in-hand, most of the time. Screening is an important preventive measure in cancer control. Even though the national programme in India has a screening component, it is yet to take root in most part of the country. At present, most of the screening tests are available at higher centers only.

OBJECTIVES:

- Create cancer awareness and remove the stigma and fear attached.
- Help people recognize early signs and symptoms of cancer, thus enabling them to seek at an early stage.
- Educate students about the key risk factors, since more than 30% of cancer cases could be prevented by modifying lifestyle or avoiding the risk factor.
- Inform women about mammograms, clinical breast exam and breast self-exam
- Inform students about the importance of regular screening and check-ups



Creating Awareness on COVID-19 Vaccination is the Need of the Hour


