

- In the introductory session, Dr. L. Chinnappa, Chair of the Anti-Ragging Committee, provided a comprehensive overview of each member's responsibilities in managing ragging complaints within the institution. The session underscored the committee's mission to foster a safe and supportive environment for all students.
- To reinforce anti-ragging measures, signage and posters have been strategically placed across the campus, including the cafeteria, classroom corridors, restrooms, and canteens. In addition, vigilance officers conducted thorough surprise inspections in various areas, such as hostels and buses. These inspections yielded no reports of ragging incidents, reflecting the effectiveness of the vigilance system.
- The committee also ensured that all students and their parents have duly completed the required anti-ragging affidavits, affirming their commitment to preventing ragging. On September 22, 2020, an awareness program was organized to further educate the campus community about anti-ragging policies and procedures.
