An Anti-Ragging Committee is formed to address the issues concerning ragging.

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
3. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
4. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
5. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
6. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

The Students gathered in Auditorium Anti ragging Members spoke about above mentioned.



The students are hereby warned that they shall not indulge in "RAGGING". If they are found guilty of ragging they are liable for the above mentioned punishment

The fresher's / junior students are also hereby instructed that they should not respond to the calls from seniors, should not participate in any kind of party anywhere inside/outside the campus, even if ordered by the seniors and that, they have nothing to fear as the institution cares for them and shall not tolerate any atrocities against them.

PRIST campus is ragging free, still all these measures have been taken to ensure that the fresher's are able to pursue their studies without getting teased, insulted or in any way troubled by the seniors in the name of an obsolete, barbaric ritual. He began by reviewing the minutes from the previous meeting and provided a detailed account of the preventive actions taken by PRIST Deemed University to combat ragging. These measures included:


- An oath administered to students upon enrollment.

- Clarification given during the time of admissions
















