 - 4. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
 - 5. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
 - 6. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

The students are here by warned that they shall not indulge in "RAGGING". If they are found guilty of ragging they are liable for the above mentioned punishment

The fresher's / junior students are also hereby instructed that they should not respond to the calls from seniors, should not participate in any kind of party anywhere inside/outside the campus, even if ordered by the seniors and that, they have nothing to fear as the institution cares for them and shall not tolerate any atrocities against them.
