PLASTIC AWARENESS RALLY (NSS Camp 2018-2019)

Our university's NSS volunteers raise a lot of awareness about the value of planting trees in the surrounding communities. The purpose of the action was to raise awareness about the deadly and detrimental effects of plastic consumption and how these issues may be effectively addressed by modifying our way of life. 180 people, including instructors, non-teaching staff, NSS and non-NSS students at the university, actively participated in the rally and the campaign by gathering plastic debris from the hamlet and properly disposing of it in the designated bins.
